Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God. Ephesians 2:19

In writing to the church in Ephesus, Paul reminds them that they are members of the household of God. When Paul, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, wrote letters to the early churches, he spoke to them in familial terms. The early church found in the Book of Acts functioned as a family and this is still how churches are to function and the church members see each other - family!

It is so easy in our modern culture to "go to church" and hear a "preacher", but have no connections as a family. But the Bible speaks of a church as a family with a pastor. A church family is different than a church and a pastor is much different than a preacher. People go to a church but a church family hurts with you, celebrates with you, ministers to you, and much more. A pastor does these as well, and is also available to assist, to teach, communicate directly with you, answer your questions, and more. Attending a church or hearing a preacher is not the same as having a church family or a pastor.
